# JAPAN: OBJECTION TO THE RESERVATION CONTAINED IN THE COMMUNICATION BY THE PLURINATIONAL STATE OF BOLIVIA $^{\rm 1}$

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

"The Permanent Mission of Japan to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretariat of the United Nations and refers to the Secretary-General's depositary notification dated 10 January 2012 (C.N.829.2011.TREATIES-28), which communicated that the Secretary-General had received from the Plurinational State of Bolivia an instrument of accession to the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs, 1961, as amended by the 1972 Protocol thereto, with a proposed reservation submitted under the procedures set forth in Article 50, paragraph 3 of the Convention.

The Government of Japan has examined the reservation made by the Plurinational State of Bolivia and understands that Bolivia's contention is based on its custom and tradition. However the Government of Japan is of the view that the reservation seems to be incompatible with the object and purpose of the Convention to prevent the illicit production, manufacture and trafficking of cocaine. Therefore, the Government of Japan objects to the aforesaid reservation.
